

Neighborhood Trees Surveyed

Southern Bronx - Community Board 2

50 neighborhood trees were surveyed in the Hunts Point neighborhood of the Bronx. All of the trees are located in Community Board 2. Of the trees surveyed, 11 were in excellent condition, 32 in good condition, and 7 in poor condition. 15 of the trees are Honeylocust (*Gleditsia triacanthos*), 7 are Northern white-cedar (*Thuja occidentalis*), and there are 6 each of Norway maple (*Acer platanoides*), Ginkgo (*Ginkgo biloba*), and London plane tree (*Platanus x acerifolia*). The most valuable tree surveyed is an estimated 82 year old Sugar maple (*Acer saccharum*) in good condition valued at \$5,145.00. The 2nd and 3rd most valuable trees are a Pin oak (*Quercus palustris*) and a Honeylocust (*Gleditsia triacanthos*) valued at \$2,286.00 and \$1,166.00 respectively and both in good condition.
